# Clinical Attachment Programme

South London and Maudsley Trust are pleased to announce the launch of our International Clinical Attachment Programme, for psychiatrists and psychiatrists-in-training.

The Maudsley Hospital is the largest mental health training institution in the UK. It is part of South London and Maudsley NHS Foundation Trust, which includes the Bethlem Royal Hospital, Lambeth Hospital, and liaison psychiatry services at King's College Hospital, Guys Hospital, Croydon University Hospital, and St Thomas Hospital.

We are an internationally renowned centre of excellence in mental healthcare and research and work in partnership with the Institute of Psychiatry, Psychology, and Neurosciences (IOPPN) King's College London. The Maudsley is part of the King's Health Partners academic health science centre.

We serve a local population of 1.3 million people in south London, providing inpatient care for over 5000 people each year and seeing more than 40,000 community patients. We also provide national specialist services for children and adults across the UK and beyond. The Maudsley Training Programme provides clinical training for 120 psychiatry residents and the Trust collaborates with several universities to provide clinical placements for nursing and psychology students.

For overseas clinicians seeking to visit the Maudsley, the International Clinical Attachment Programme offers experiences which may include:

- Observing clinical practice in mental healthcare across a range of general psychiatric services
- Observation of specialist clinical services including mood disorders, eating disorders, personality disorders, early intervention and treatment-resistant psychosis services, neuropsychiatry, forensic, consultation liaison, and child mental health
- Involvement in research activities
- Attendance at Trust-based educational and knowledge sharing events such as Grand Rounds and Journal Club

Clinical Observers will have the opportunity to visit for up to three months and may rotate through multiple services at different hospital sites or remain with one speciality, with agreement from that department. Choice of placements will be dependent on availability, which may be limited due to demand.
